

## **R. Adams Dudley**



R. Adams Dudley, M.D., M.B.A., is Associate Professor in the Institute for Health Policy Studies, the Department of Medicine, and the Department of Epidemiology and Biostatistics at the University of California, San Francisco. His research interests include: developing improved measures of quality of care; improving techniques to adjust for the financial risk that health plans and providers face based on the prevalence and severity of illness among their enrollees; and assessing the feasibility of changing the relative weights put on quality

versus price by participants in the health care market. Based on his research, he has authored and co-authored numerous articles in scientific journals. Dr. Dudley received his M.B.A. from Stanford University's Graduate School of Business in 1990 and his M.D. from Duke University in 1991. He is Board Certified in Internal Medicine and Pulmonary Medicine. He was a Pew Fellow in Health Policy at UCSF from 1995 to 1997 before joining the UCSF faculty.
