David Shactman is a Senior Research Associate at the Schneider Institute for Health Policy at Brandeis University and the Project Director of the Council on Health Care Economics and Policy. In his capacity as Director, he has been the author of numerous reports and publications. His primary research has been in the areas of access to health insurance coverage, hospital emergency department overcrowding, and health policy issues for aging populations. He has also published and spoken on the topic of health market competition, consolidation, and antitrust. Prior to his work for the Council, Mr. Shactman managed expert consensus panels that developed clinical practice guidelines for the Agency for Health Care Policy and Research. He was also a consultant in the private sector where he facilitated complex negotiations for hospital systems and for siting of health facilities.

Before working in the health care sector, Mr. Shactman was Founder and President of a chain of retail specialty stores located in Greater Boston and Philadelphia. He was also general partner of The Drumlin Group, a real estate development and consulting company located on Boston's North Shore.

Mr. Shactman has an MPA in Health Policy from Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government and an MBA in Finance from Columbia University. He presently resides in Newton, Massachusetts.
