Ms. Chambers is responsible for analyzing strategic hospital issues, including hospital quality measurement and reporting, patient safety, and coverage for the uninsured. In addition, she serves as Corporate Secretary, overseeing corporate activities of the association and working with the Board of Directors and the Board of Governors; and she is involved with outreach to the business and government and regulatory communities. Prior to her current position, Ms. Chambers was Vice President for Legislation and Political Affairs at the Federation and represented the Federation on a wide range of issues of interest to hospitals to Members of Congress, their professional staff, and to members of the Bush Administration. She also served as Director of the Federation's Political Action Committee (FedPAC).

Prior to joining the Federation, Ms. Chambers served as Vice President of Government and Professional Affairs for the College of American Pathologists, where she oversaw lobbying activities and practice management issues, served on the executive staff, coordinated the development and analysis of public policy positions, and managed the group's satellite office. Ms. Chambers also served as Assistant Director of Congressional Affairs with the American Medical Association; Executive Director of the Ripon Society and the Ripon Educational Fund; and as a Legislative Assistant for Representatives James A.S. Leach (R-IA) and Thomas J. Tauke (R-IA).

Ms Chambers earned a Master of Business Administration degree from The George Washington University, a Bachelor of Arts degree from The College of Wooster, and has nearly completed a Bachelor of Arts degree in interior design from Marymount University. She is involved with numerous civic activities and serves as a Trustee of The College of Wooster.
