
## SITE-NEUTRAL (E) MEDICARE CUTS



## So called "site-neutral" cuts jeopardize access to care for patients and communities, and undermine the safety net.

These ill-conceived policies cut Medicare payments for hospital care in order to match payment rates for ambulatory surgery centers (ASCs) and physician practices. Hospitals, unlike these other settings, provide 24/7 care, treat sicker patients, and have stricter compliance standards.
